€10,000 STEM Grant

We are thrilled to announce that Owenbeg N.S. has been in receipt of a STEM education grant from the Department of Education to the value of €10,000. After a lengthy and detailed application, we were chosen from over 2,700 schools in Ireland and sanctioned the funds to implement our project "Developing 21st Century Skills Through Teaching and Learning in Sustainability and Outdoor Learning".

Using the STEM grant, we have purchased 10 new touchscreen devices, a secure charging trolley and 10 LEGO Spike kits. All pupils have already put these devices and Lego kits to good use and we look forward to using them more in the months and years to come.
